DEFINITIONS

○ This is organized by time and main events that have happened. You use this when you want to organize things by time or in order.

○ This is a narrative or written work with a beginning, middle, and end. There are usually characters, a specific setting, and sometimes a problem and solution.

○ This is used when you have a main topic or category with several sub-topics or sub-categories. It is organized with the sub-topics branching off from the main topic.

○ This is when you have specific things that you need to answer.

○ This is a written work with many paragraphs containing an introduction, several main ideas and details, and a conclusion.
