

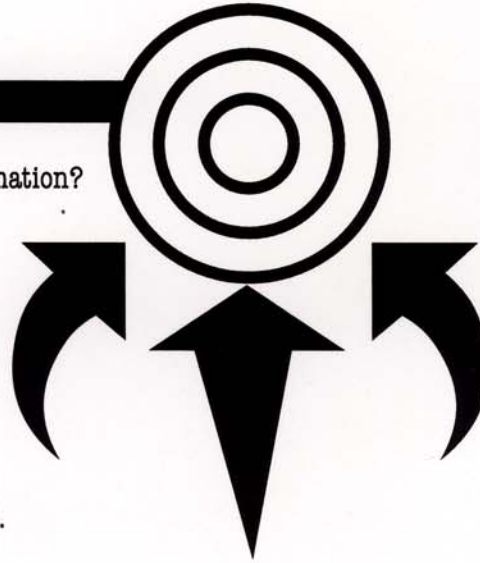
Synthesis 5.2

Event-line/Timeline
